

Summer Up! Shadow Visits

Your student has been invited to participate in the final step of our admissions process and is scheduled for an upcoming shadow visit during our Summer Up! camp. Please review the information below before your visit.

Arrival and Check-In

- Please arrive and enter through the South Entrance of the school.
- A parent must escort students into the building for check in at 9:00 am on the first day.
- Upon arrival, you will sign in your student and be asked to provide the office with emergency contact information. You will also be issued a carpool tag for the drop-off/pick-up lines.
- We do not administer medication to students who are shadowing.
- Parents can stay for a guided tour following drop off

Duration

Our K-1st grade shadows join us for two half days (9am-12am) and one a day over three days, and our 2nd-12th grade shadows join us for three consecutive days (9 am-4pm) unless otherwise agreed upon. During the visit, an administrator may contact you if needed.

What to Expect for Summer Up!

- Shadows are assigned to follow a Trinity student in the same cohort/grade level for three days.
- Students will be encouraged to engage and participate in discussions and activities. They will be moving to and from classes with their assigned shadow.
- Prospective students are administered academic assessments in reading and math by certified and licensed faculty. These assessments are for internal purposes only and are not diagnostic.
- Counselors and administrators will also meet prospective students to learn more about them.
- Our two-week camp for grades K-8 provides an exciting mix of academic instruction combined with STEAM activities that make camp a fun experience!

Program Overview:

- Dates: June 7th-19th
- Daily Schedule:
 - Morning: Students receive two hours of reading and math intensives, taught by Trinity School's Certified Academic Language Therapists and Certified Teachers.
 - Lunch: Please **pack a lunch for your child each day**. Students can also bring a labeled water bottle and sunscreen for use in outdoor activities.
 - Afternoon: STEAM activities, including art, gaming, music, science, and outdoor activities.

Additional Information:

- Gaming Club: Students may bring their own gaming devices for our gaming club sessions.
- Snacks: Snacks will be provided daily.
- Supplies: All necessary supplies for activities will be provided by the school.

**Dismissal/Pickup**

Dismissal is at 4:00 PM in the office at the school's south entrance or through the carpool line on the west side entrance. Please arrive before 4pm to pick up your student.

Next Steps

After your student completes their visit, teachers and administrators provide feedback on their experience to our admissions committee. The committee reviews that information, parent discussions, prospective student feedback, and testing and assessment information. The committee votes to accept or decline admission.

Moving Forward

If a student is not accepted at Trinity, it is typically because our programs do not provide the support your student needs to excel. Our administrators and counselors strive to provide families with recommendations about programs and services that could better support their student. Prospective students may be invited to shadow more than once before they are admitted to Trinity.
